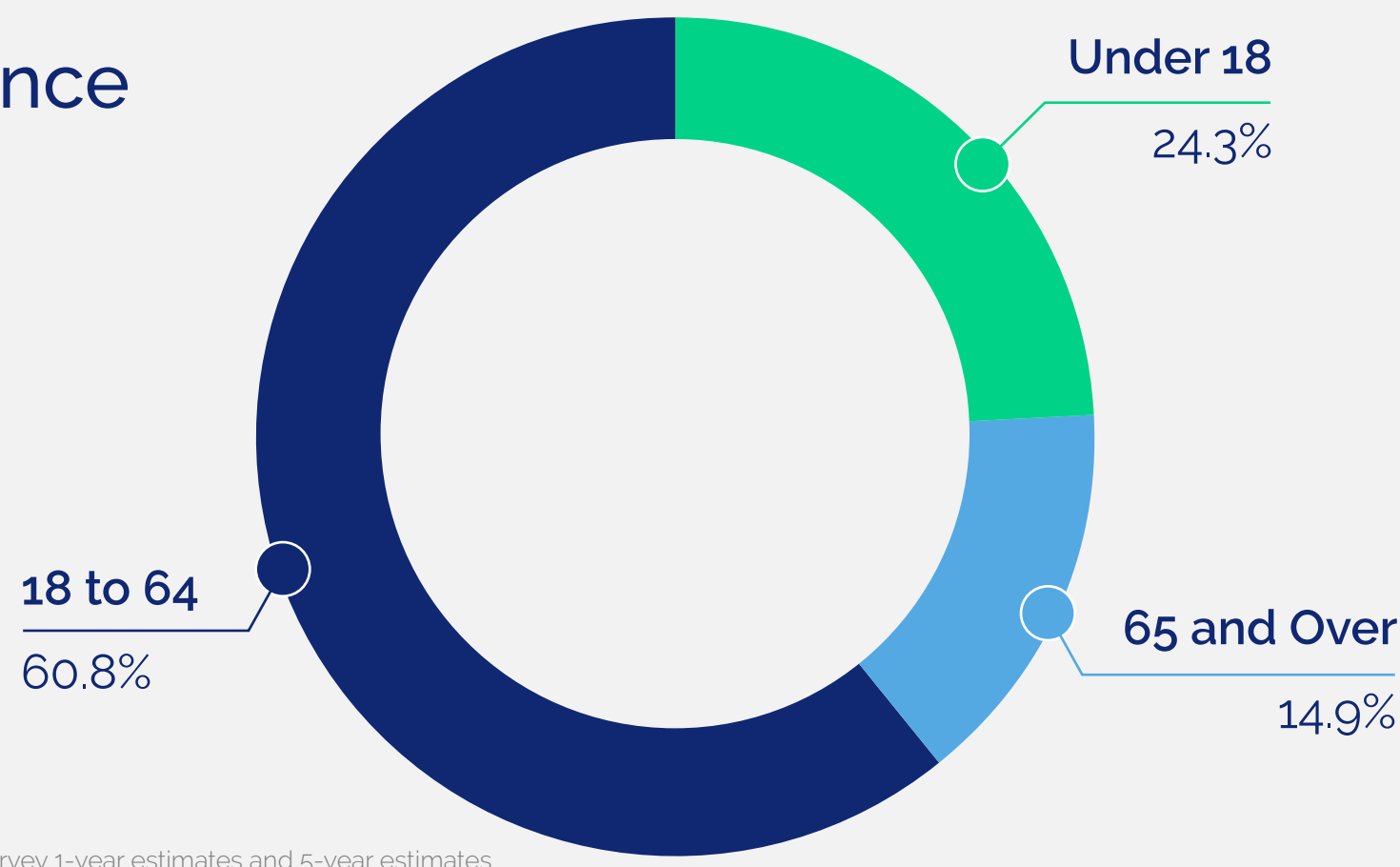

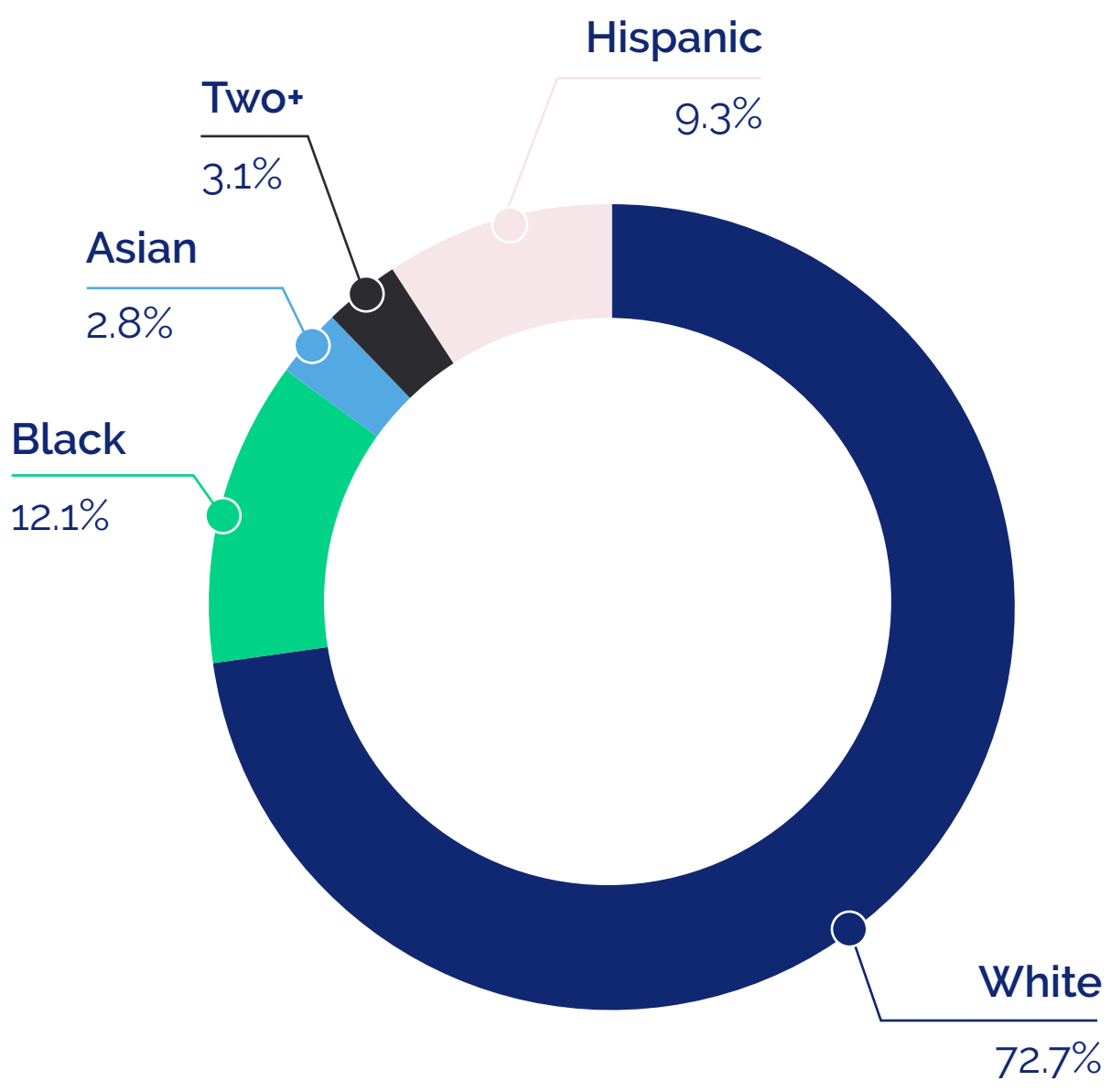
Kansas City at a Glance

Population by Age



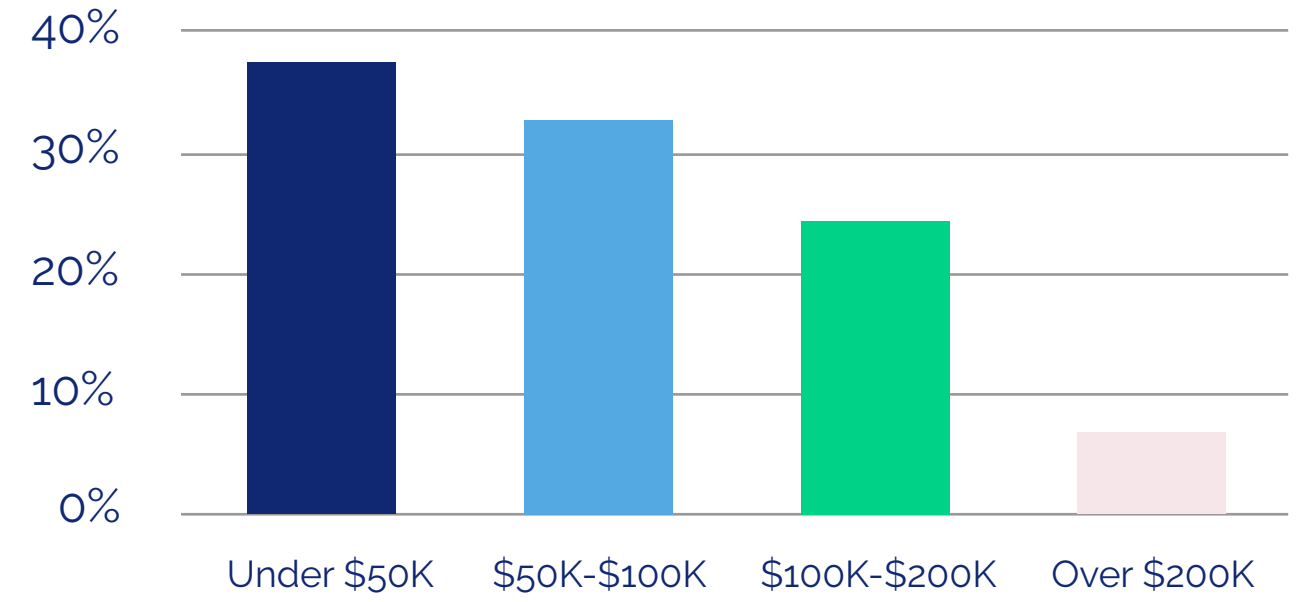

About 14% higher than the amount in Kansas: \$57,422

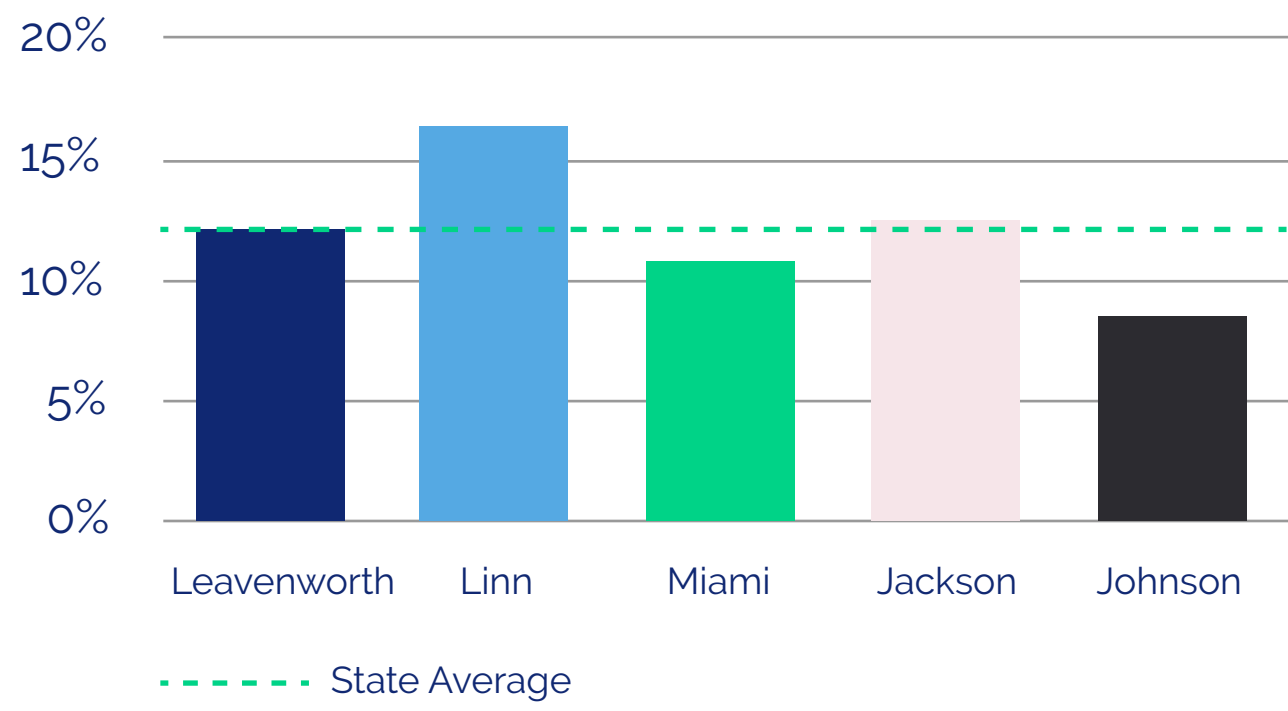
Overall population living below poverty line: 9.7%

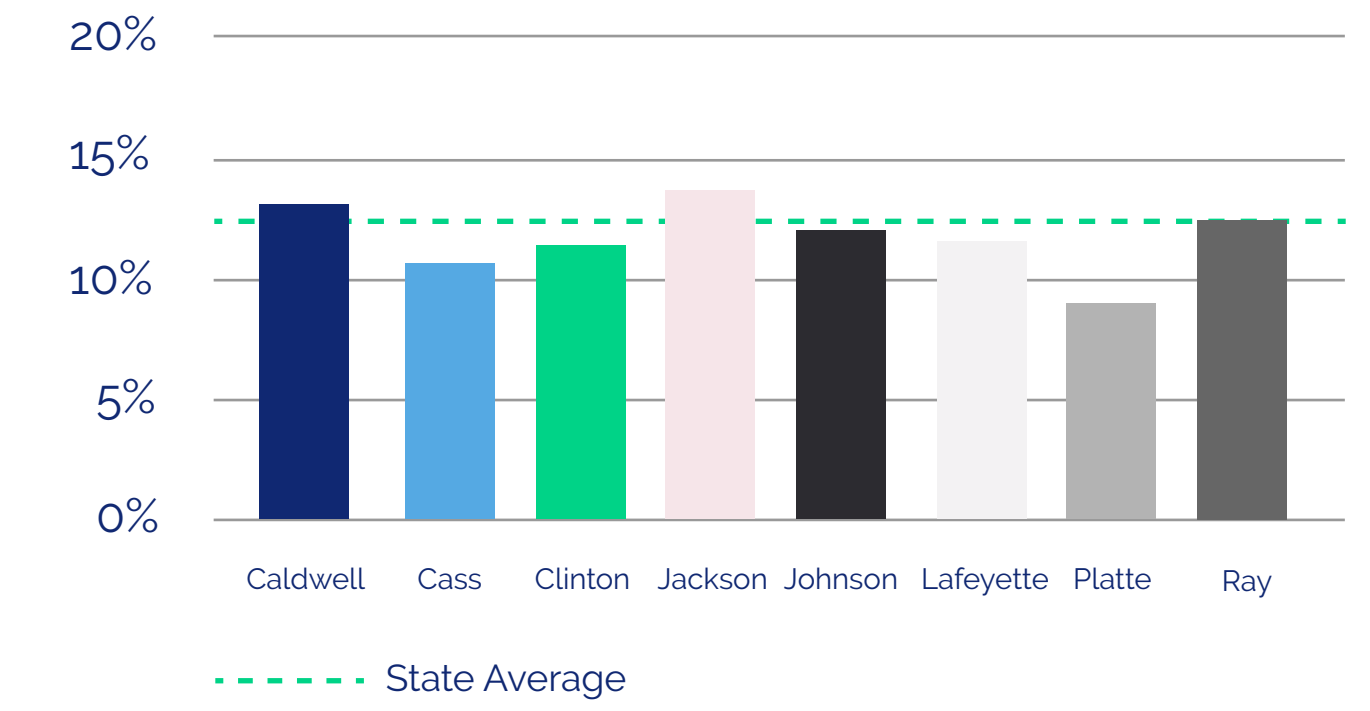
Few Counties are Facing Food Insecurity

KS 368,700 Food Insecure People

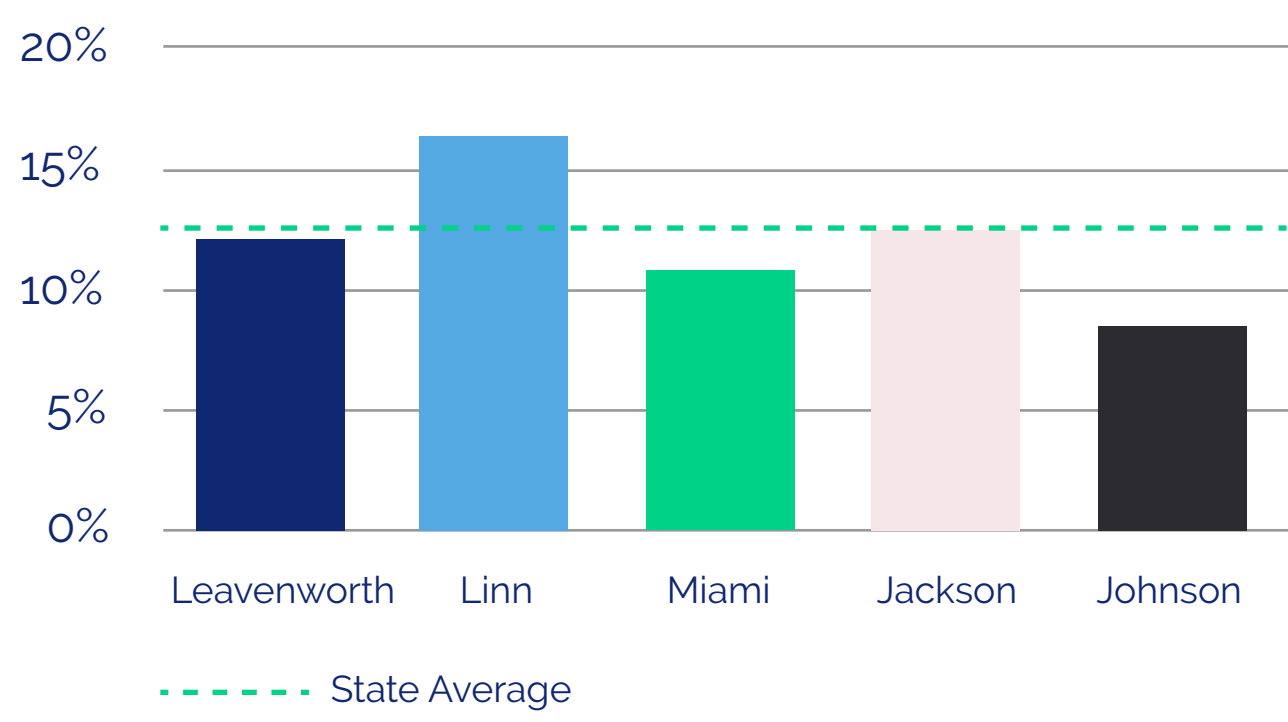

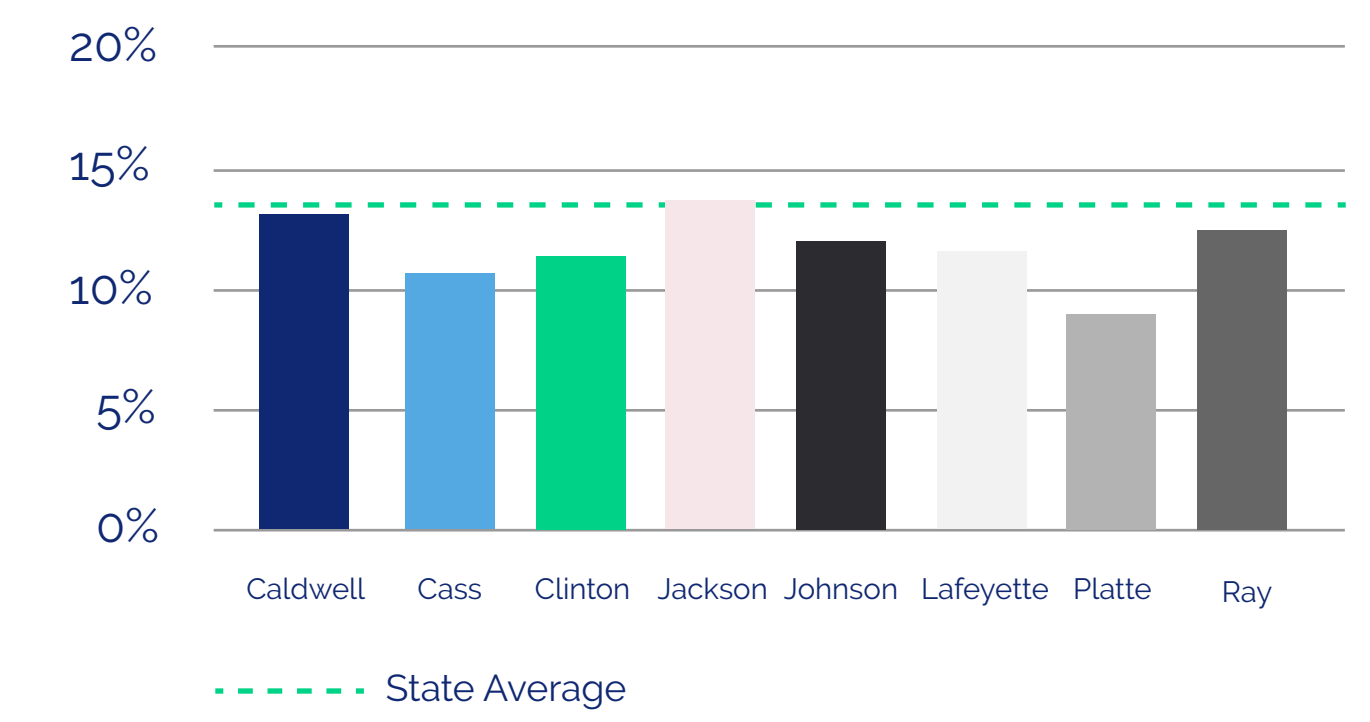
MO 813,840 Food Insecure People



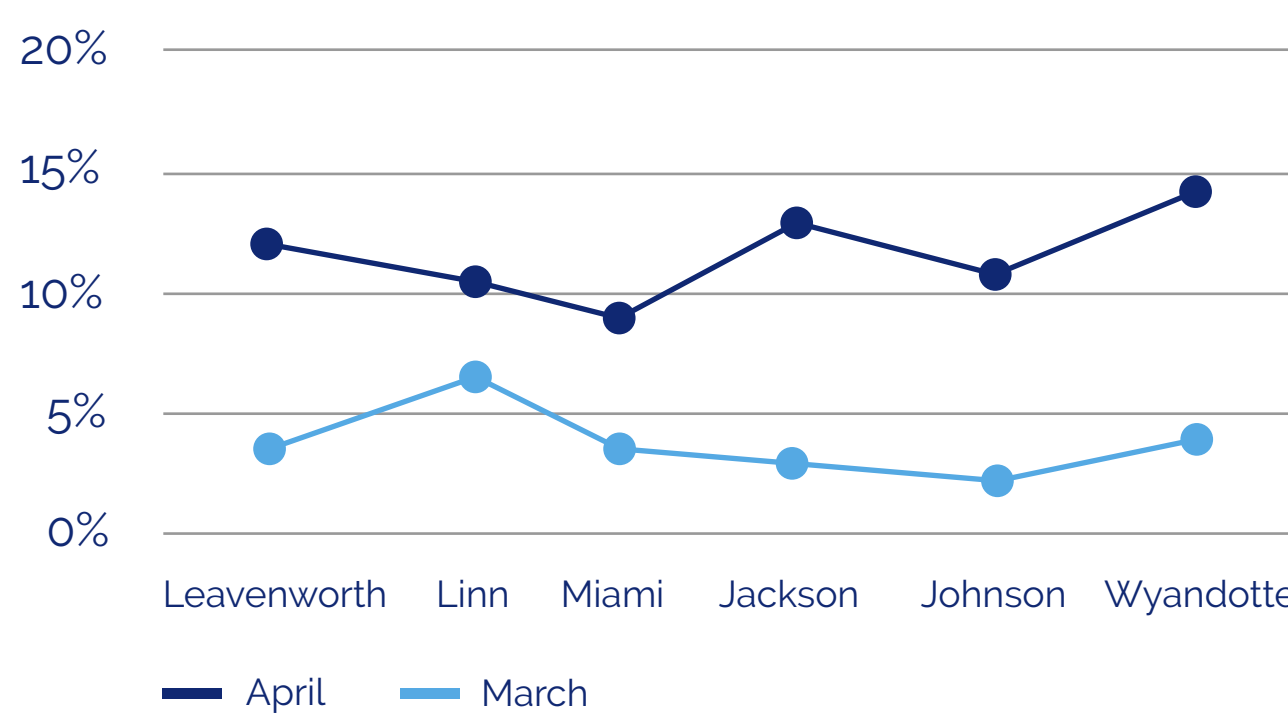
Some Counties Face Housing Challenges



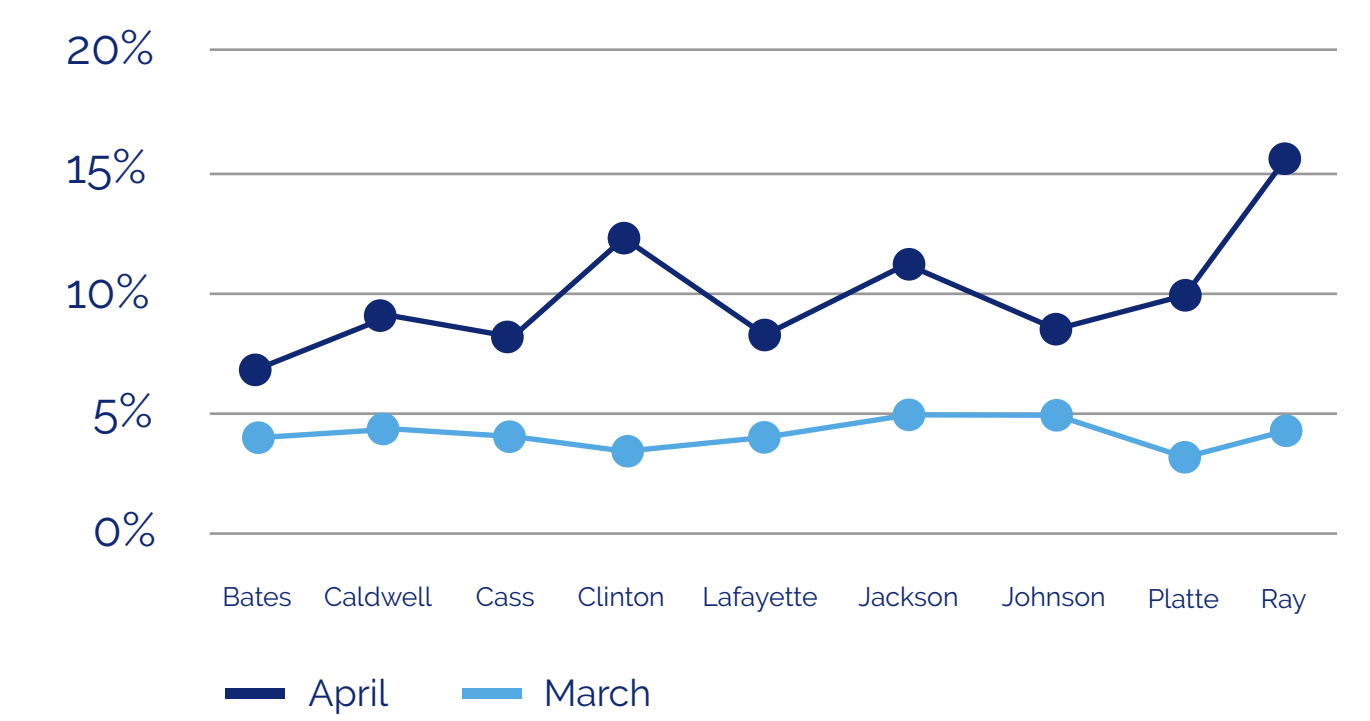
